You are officially receiving interactive drumming for your students from Rhythm Path LLC Drum Circle Facilitators. This will be a great day for everyone involved.

Here's what you need to know to make this a successful day.

Equipment needed:

- Chairs for all participants. Please inform Rhythm Path if you cannot provide chairs for alternative set-up options.
- Electricity
- Rhythm Path will bring all needed sound equipment

Choose a location where enough chairs can be set up comfortably in a circle. I recommend a large multi-purpose room, such as a cafeteria or gymnasium. There is a picture at the end of this letter on how the chairs should be set up. I also recommend armless chairs. Chairs with arms are rather cumbersome.

Remember that drums have the potential of being really loud. This will be a facilitated event so we will be making beautiful sounds, not noise. I do suggest that the room we use should be away from quiet offices or rooms where another event is taking place.

Participants will need **NOT** to wear skirts/dresses that day...because they will have a drum between their legs. No metal hand jewelry like rings, watches and bracelets either. If they forget, I will remind them to check their hands before playing the drum. The drum and/or jewelry can be damaged while playing with jewelry.

Set Up Diagram – Rhythm Path Drum Circles

*Up to 210 chairs can be set up. Only set up as many chairs as you will need.

*Facilitator can adjust chairs as needed.

*Place the chairs side to side as close together as possible

*There should be about 2 feet of space between circles (chair is 2 feet behind chair in front)

1st Circle (inner) – 20 Armless Chairs

2nd Circle – 36 Armless Chairs

3rd Circle – 52 Armless Chairs

4th Circle – 64 Armless Chairs

5th Circle (outer) – 38 Armless Chairs

The circle is set up in quadrants – 4 walking aisles and a large open center
